Class	Musical	Costume Suggestions
Kindergarten	The Lion King	Think safari colours like brown, khaki, yellow, orange etc. Animal print and animal ears are welcome!
1A & 1B	Annie	Wear neutral colours like brown, black, grey, beige. You could include mismatched socks, plaid shirt, apron, and "bedhead" messy hair.
1C	Grease	1950's style outfit. This could include a white t-shirt or a polo with a popped collar, jeans slightly rolled up at the bottom, a leather or denim jacket, poodle skirts, cardigans, headbands, neck scarves, slicked and/or styled hair.
2A & 2B	Wicked	Green tops and bottoms (the more green, the better!). If you have any whacky green accessories such as hats, wigs, capes and gloves etc, those would be great additions as well!
3A	Aladdin	A blue, teal or purple tops and dark bottoms. Feel free to add gold accessories and a sash/scarf tied around the waist.
3B	Mamma Mia	Think 1970's disco! Wear anything with yellow and orange colours! If you want to add some flare, try wide leg pants, funky prints, sparkle, fringe, sequins and a party spirit!
4A & 4B	Matilda The Musical	Neutral colours like grey, navy, and black. Think formal school uniform attire with collared shirts, polo, necktie, knee high socks, slacks, neat & tidy hair
